MINISTRY NEWS

Coimbatore, India

Our Second Annual Pastor's Conference in India was a great success. There were 239 national pastors in attendance along with the senior college students of South India Baptist Bible College. Our team of 9 men taught 15 sessions on various topics.

We held a dedication service for the completion of new facilities FBI will be using to train translators. There is such great potential to see Scriptures provided for unreached people groups of India.

We also came to an agreement on the purchase and installation of a printing press on the campus. It will be a joint venture and will be used by the college for their own needs as well as the printing of Scriptures once they have been translated. It will also be available as the need arises to do other Scripture printing projects for that part of the world. We thank the Lord for this progress and anticipate great things.

Mali, West Africa

Our April 24th departure date for Mali is fast approaching. This will be a survey trip with some exciting potential plans. First, we plan to partner with some Malian churches which already have some men committed to enroll in a church planter training program. These men will then be partnered with U.S. churches and sent out as church planters.

The next phase of this will be the translation of Bible stories to be put on video CD's. We have targeted several people groups which are not only unreached, but also unengaged, meaning there is NO Christian activity among them of any kind.

Please pray the Lord will open the doors and allows us to form profitable partnerships for the sake of God's glory in Mali.
