MINISTRY NEWS

Plans are on schedule for the upcoming school year at WorldView Institute in India. We have 8 or 9 students enrolled and hope to have a total of 10-12



students by the start of school in mid-June.

The Lord has given us a team of 6 teachers this year. Two of them will be in India for the entire year. The others will travel to India to teach for 2 weeks to 12 weeks each.

This full-scale Master's degree program will require much work and the Lord has provided the team necessary to get the job done. They are dedicated, qualified and committed to the task. We are grateful for them!!

We desire your prayers because training Bible translators is a sacred work. We desire to be very thorough in subject material, diligent in our teaching and faithful to the truth of God's Word.

The 2012-13 school year financial needs are:

• Student Scholarships (\$1,500)

This will provide the entire year's costs for each student. The advantage of training nationals is they don't have to learn the language or the culture.

• Teacher Sponsorships (\$2,000)

With six teachers traveling to India at approximately \$2000 per trip, and some of them making 2 trips, the expenses are expected to exceed \$16,000.00.

Please prayerfully consider sponsoring a student or a teacher. The potential impact of this work cannot be measured. It will mean the translation of God's Word for multiple language groups who have never had Scripture in their own language.

Genesis Project / Songhai

This ground-breaking project is a plan to print Genesis and the four Gospels in booklet form for Muslim people groups across north Africa. Eleven languages have been targeted. The first will be the Songhai language.

The Songhai people (3.5 million) are 99% Muslim. They are scattered across Mali, Niger, Nigeria, Benin and Burkina Faso.

This will be the first printing of Scripture for this people group. It is a recent translation. Our distribution team is in place. The funds for this project have been given. We are waiting on the final details on printing costs.
