This summer they will be launching a new translation project for the Khongso people of Myanmar. Stephen has been an outstanding student. He returned in the early part of this current school year to help us teach a Greek class.

Rama is the son of the tribal leader. The Khongso people have been praying for over 50 years that God would send someone to help them get the Bible in their own language. A few years ago, God put this burden in Rama's heart.

Rama earned a bachelor's degree in one school and a master of divinity degree in another. Then someone told him about WorldView Institute. He came to us two years ago and has also been an outstanding student. He is 30 years old with a wife and three children.

He has already assembled a translation committee of fifteen people from the local churches and recruited a team of ten people to serve as translators. Their training begins later this summer.

Please pray that God will help me be faithful to the task He left me here to accomplish. I want Him to be glorified through my life.

Emily's Determination and Donation

Soon after my illness, Emily revealed her heart for the world when she told me, "Daddy, if God had taken you on to Heaven, I would take your place at WorldView and keep on working to get the Bible to people who don't have one. I would not let that work stop!"

Just a few days ago, I was sitting in my office when Emily came in and asked what I was doing. I answered, "I'm working on paying some of the medical and hospital bills." She asked, "How much is it?" "It is a lot of money, Sweet Pea," I replied.

Later that day, she came back in the office with her hand behind her back. She walked up to my desk and handed me an envelope and announced, "This is from the money that I was saving for something special." The envelope read, "To: Hospital Bills, From: Emily." Inside were three one-dollar bills and some change. I could only respond with tears. We are so thankful for her tender and compassionate heart.

As you can imagine, seven days in the hospital with four days in Cardiac ICU has resulted in some astronomical costs. I am so grateful to the churches and individuals who, without solicitation, sent love offerings toward these bills. As far as I know, with these gifts and the Christian medical sharing plan in which we participate, our bills will all be covered. Praise the LORD!!!
