Buy a Verse!!

I am grateful for friends who recommended WorldView Ministries to Pastor Brian McLaughlin and Fairview Baptist Church in Decatur, AL. I had never met Pastor McLaughlin, but after a few phone calls, a plan was formulated. They chose to partner with us in the Madi Translation Project for Northern Uganda.

Each project is different, but we estimated the total cost of translating the New Testament, then divided that by the number of verses in the New Testament. That came to roughly \$25.00 per verse.

Fairview Baptist Church chose to adopt the Epistle of Romans - all 433 verses! They created a poster for each of the sixteen chapters with a blank line beside each verse so church members could sign up to buy that verse. (see below)

The verses were sold one by one. Some chose to buy many verses. A couple of members purchased entire chapters. Romans 8:28 was the favorite verse of several people, so they all wanted it. Pastor McLaughlin decided to auction it off—it sold for \$1000.00!!

During the Sunday morning service, I was presented with a check — the final total was \$13,150.00. We are so thankful for the burden God gave Pastor McLaughlin and the generous giving of Fairview Baptist Church for the vital work of Bible translation. THANK YOU FAIRVIEW!!
