Financial Gift

Please allow me to present a wonderful opportunity for you to make a real difference in reaching the unreached. A man who wishes to remain anonymous has given permission for us to share his commitment to the work of FirstBible International. He is giving a \$75,000 matching funds gift for the work of church planting, national training and the publishing of Scriptures for the unreached.

Our challenge is to raise the matching funds. Would you consider this chance to give an offering that would have double impact? Every dollar you give would become two. We are grateful for what God is accomplishing through FirstBible and we appreciate God's people seeing this vision and partnering with us to impact those who have never heard.

The Project

We have committed to print 5000 Bibles in the Farsi language. These Bibles will be transported into Iran via horseback to distribution points from which they will be taken to underground churches. The brave couriers doing this work are risking their very lives. Recently, one of them was caught and all of his fingernails pulled out. Others have stepped up to take his place.
