PROJECTS UPDATE

1. Restricted Nations Project (Bibles for Closed Countries)

Our container of Scriptures for distribution to restricted nations arrived on the *Zim Barcelona* on **January 4th**. It has been off-loaded and preparations are being made to transport the Scriptures across a couple of borders to our target nation. Please pray for the safety of all involved in this risky but worthy endeavor.

The **Printing Project** inside a restricted nation is progressing. We can print as many New Testaments as we can raise funds to cover at a cost of \$4 each. Please continue to give toward this marking your checks: **Muslim Project** or **Restricted Nations Project**.

We are talking about a nation where the government has greatly increased its efforts in the last few days to keep their promise to eradicate all Christian activity. Many have been arrested and jailed since Christmas. These believers need our earnest prayers and help.

Genesis & Matthew

We have launched a new project to print Genesis & Matthew for restricted Muslim nations in North Africa. These books of the Bible stir curiosity among Muslims because of they contain information about Abraham. We are targeting 10 language groups in 5 nations. Mark your gifts toward this project: **Genesis & Matthew**.

2. Mali Project

Our Bible Storying project has expanded from 6 languages to 26 languages. We are happy to report that the cost has been reduced to about \$8,000.00 per language.

Phase 1 is complete in two languages and is in process for two more. Please mark gifts for this project: **Mali Storying**. If you cannot fund an entire language, you may choose to fund one story for \$180.00. There are 25 OT and 25 NT stories per language.

3. India Project

Our third annual Pastor's Conference will be held February 1-3. Please pray for our team of pastors and missionaries who will be preaching and teaching. We are expecting 200+ national pastors to attend.

During this conference, we will have opportunity to recruit more students for the FirstBible Institute of Linguistics which launches in July. Please pray that God will burden many students for this great cause.
