



India Evangelistic Crusade

The Lord truly blessed the evangelistic crusade in South India. The attendance started out at just over 1,000 on the first night and built each night with well over 3,000 attending on the final night.

It was estimated that anywhere from 50% to 80% of the crowd each night were lost people.

The first message each night was focused on the simple steps of Christian growth for the believers who were present. The second message was focused on presenting the gospel to the lost.

Our desire was to present the gospel as clearly as possible focusing on sin and our need for a Saviour and on the death, burial and resurrection of Christ. We realize it is the LORD who works in the hearts of men, but **we praise Him for a total of 714 adults who came forward to profess faith in Jesus Christ during the five-night meeting.**

The services were interpreted into the local language which is Tamil. On the final night, there were interpreters for 5 Indian languages with the main Tamil crowd being the largest percentage and four other language groups sitting at the perimeter of the soccer field. These languages were Telugu, Manipuri, Soura and Oriya.
