Runyankore Project

This project has been in process since 2007. Dan Olachea opened the recent *Pastors and Workers Literacy Training Week* with a scriptural challenge and I had the privilege of preaching to the 37 attendees at the close of the week. The rest of the classes were taught by our translation team.

Ma'adi Project

Have you ever experienced a real "divine appointment?" I had one last October when I met Missionary Sam Moss who was on deputation to Arua, Uganda. Without knowing who I was or anything about the work of our ministry, Sam expressed his burden for the translation of God's Word into the Ma'adi language.

Dan Olachea, our Translation Coordinator, had helped start a project in this language a few years ago but due to unfortunate circumstances, the project ended soon after it began. We believe God raised up Sam Moss to see this project re-started.

Each of the translators has had advanced theological training. A series of Greek classes is now being taught and there will be ongoing training in translation principles and philosophy.

We were moved to tears as these men shared their deep burden for the Word of God in their own language. Thom expressed, *"We have prayed for many years, wondering why other peoples can have the Word of God and we do not have it. But with WorldView coming to Arua, we believe God has shown us favor and our time has come."*

Each man, without hesitation, committed to move his family 5 hours from their current home to Arua and serve 5-7 years working full time on this project.



The work God has been doing behind the scenes is obvious. **I stand in awe!** If I have ever felt the Lord's divine hand in a project, it is with this one. Please prayerfully consider helping support the Ma'adi Project.
