We depart April 4th for Arua, Uganda. On this trip we will host a Pastors Conference for Madi speaking pastors, take part in the ordination of three men to the gospel ministry AND...we will be officially launching our **Madi Translation Project!!**

After two years of training and preparation, the five Madi-speaking men have moved to Arua with their families and are getting settled in. They will have a Greek refresher course before we arrive in April. Our staff will spend two weeks with them getting them in the routine and process of translating the New Testament into the Madi Language.

We are thrilled to officially begin this project. There have been many obstacles to overcome, but we see the Lord working and meeting needs.
