Each year, we go away from these meetings greatly encouraged in the work of Bible translation. Our purpose and burden is to see God raise an army of Bible translators for the 4,000+ language groups still waiting for God's Word.

June 6-17 had us busy with MIT (Missionary in Training). In partnership with Dr. Bill Patterson and Pastor Tim Matthews, we organized a week of missions and evangelism training at a summer camp in Louisiana with 24 teenagers.

Following the week of training, we all flew to New York City. The training continued there, as well as the opportunity to work with 6 different pastors in evangelistic activities among various ethnic groups. About 60% of Queens, NY is foreign-born. It was a life-changing experience the young people will never forget. So far, one of the teens has surrendered to be a missionary.

## New Staff Member

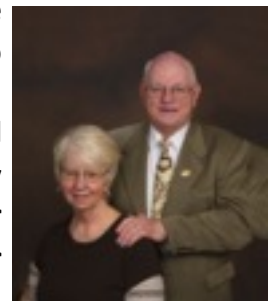
