The **ASANG KHONGSO** Project (Myanmar) workers are now in the Gospel of John. Our Associate recently moved closer to the city in order to have more reliable electricity and access to more resources.

The **MADI PROJECT** (Arua, Uganda) Associate, Sam Moss, is returning to the states and has accepted the pastorate of his home church in Iowa, but will remain involved in our project at a high level. He will leave on May 15 to return to Uganda for a five-week visit. Please pray for the project during this transition and that the team will stabilize under new leadership on the field. We are very close to printing the Gospel of Mark.

MIT (MISSIONARY IN TRAINING)

For the second year, I will partner with Bill Patterson and Tim Matthews of Mt. Abarim Baptist Missions to host a Missionary-In-Training program for young people. We will spend a week at Southland Christian Camp teaching on missions and Bible translation.
