Our 2018 Annual Team Meeting was a wonderful time of inspiration and instruction. We had 63 registered delegates for the 3-day meeting and the Lord truly blessed. Bill Patterson delivered a wonderful message to start off the conference. Glenn Kerr taught 7 sessions on the philosophy and process of Bible translation. We also had three testimonies from Bible translators. Bill Patterson shared the story of the translation of the Mongolian NT, Haile Emiru is working on the Amharic NT and Marilyn Pitzer shared her story of 40+ years in Venezuela helping to translate the Bible for the Warao people. We left the meeting fired up and we are praying God will bring more laborers into the work.

Madi Update (Uganda)

3,000 copies of the Gospel of Mark have been printed, delivered and are being distributed this weekend!!! After the move back to their home district of Adjumani, Robert, one of our original team members, rejoined the project and the men are working full time and moving forward at a good pace.

New Project (Iran)

We are in the process of launching a brand new translation project for a people group in Iran. This is EXCITING! A single lady is already committed and a young couple is praying about joining WorldView to lead this project. It will be in cooperation with a church in Ohio that took the burden for this almost seven years ago. The Lord is opening doors and is very much at work. More details to come later.

Trip to Nepal (Tibetan Project)

Late this evening two WorldView staff, Bob McQueary and Bill Fennell, will join me as we depart for Kathmandu, Nepal where our Tibetan Project is based. Our goal is to spend some time with the Levine Family, our translation team, and Bishwa, our intern from India.

Bishwa graduated from WorldView Institute of India in March 2017 and is almost finished with his one year internship with us in Nepal. God gave him and his fellow student, Hencha, a great burden for the Layap people of Bhutan. We will discuss future plans to reach them this week.
