The military is once again locking down the country and placing severe restrictions on the people and their freedoms. Some Americans serving there have been ordered to return to the USA.

Our Associate is a native and will not have to leave the country, but this will make the work more difficult. The internet has been shut down in many areas and there is threat of total shutdown. This would cut off communication with our team. The goal for printing this NT is sometime in 2023. Please pray they will be able to continue their work freely, that we can maintain communication and the project will not be delayed.
