Our associate has already begun the process of learning Hebrew and is committed to the translation of the Old Testament also.

We are still asking for prayer for the process of getting the books into the country. Please pray for the safety of everyone involved.

Madi Project (Uganda)

Wangai and Michele are home for a short visit and were able to be in our home church's mission conference last week. It was a great blessing to hear their report of all that God is doing.

We believe we are on target for finishing the NT in 2024 and the OT by 2026 (work has already begun on the OT). Please pray for God's help. The need is so great for the believers and churches there.

The tribal conflict continues to threaten the area. We are looking at a second relocation for our translation team. Please pray for their safety and that God will help them remain focused on the work.
