Our travels have taken us far and wide in the last year. In addition to dozens of meetings in the USA, we visited all three Uganda projects in December 2024, traveled to India in February, the Persia Project in March, and Nicaragua in August.

WorldView Institute — The transition to national leadership has been going very well. With the continued oversight of the Overtons, in the last couple of months, we have had module classes taught by Matthew Patenaude, the Ngonamais and Lydia (our graduate serving with us in the Tibetan Project).

Runyankore Project — **WE ARE ALMOST READY!!!** The final proofreading for the Runyankore WHOLE BIBLE is almost done. We should have the files in hand in just a few days and the formatting should be ready for the printing presses in January. This will be WorldView's first completed whole Bible project and we are so excited!!

Madi Project — **Target date for printing the Madi NT is early-to-mid 2026.** This will be another celebratory milestone for our ministry. Anders Swanson moved to the field in September and is overseeing the final steps in the translation. He has also begun training the team in Hebrew so they can move seamlessly right into OT translation work. We are grateful for the commitment of this good team of men.

Liangmai Project — Another celebratory milestone is on the horizon in the completion of the Liangmai NT. In spite of much chaos and relocations of the project for safety's sake, the work has continued. **Our target date for printing this NT is also early-to-mid 2026.**

Some work has already been done on the OT, so for the first time we plan to print the NT along with Psalms and Proverbs. This will be so helpful to the churches in Manipur and we are praising the Lord!

Persia Project — We now have a new video for this project but can't post it publicly. Any of our WorldView staff would be happy to show it in your church. Please contact us to schedule a meeting.

After 14 years of prayer, **we just hired our first two native speakers to be trained for translation work! Praise the LORD!!!!**

For a while now, we have been saying, "WorldView has 9 projects in 6 different countries." We have been praying for new ones and the Lord has answered!

NICARAGUA — In August we made a survey trip to Nicaragua. We have been praying for three years about launching a translation for the Miskito in Nicaragua and Honduras. God has given us the associate who will lead it. Caleb Eaton will finish his training and begin deputation in May 2026 and get to the field as soon as his support is raised. God has also give us contacts in with native speakers who have the potential to be trained to help us.

CAMEROON — Discussion began in October about joining forces with a missionary for a project in Cameroon, Africa. After a few weeks of prayer, we will meet again next month to finalize the details. The associate AND the translation team is already in place and WorldView training will begin early next year. This project will include translation work in three languages simultaneously.
