Runyankore Printing Project

We have placed the order for 6,000 copies of the Runyankore Bible!! Praise the Lord!!

A rough estimate on delivery is late November. We will keep you informed when they have been delivered.

Madi Printing Project

We are still on target for printing the NT in 2026. Hebrew language training has already begun in preparation for translation of the Old Testament. Our Madi translators are faithful men and in addition to working on the Scriptures, all of them serve as pastors with a heart to reach people with the gospel.

Liangmai Printing Project

The reports are tragic and the strife continues. The Indian Army has stepped in and their harsh treatment of the people has provoked mass mobs of violence even closer to where our team is located. Concerning the group that was kidnapped a few weeks ago, the women and children were released, but the men were brutally tortured, dismembered and killed. Terrible atrocities were committed against these families that are too violent to relate in this newsletter. ***Please keep praying for their safety!***
